



- That evening, gather with the group for a welcome drink and dinner beneath the stars, paired with a stunning light show at the pyramids.


















FAQS Egypt

Which airport do I need to fly in and out?	Fly into Cairo (CAI) and out of Sharm El Sheikh (SSH)
What time should my flight arrive and leave?	Fly In: Most will likely be on a flight arriving before 6 PM in Cairo. However, you can also take the overnight flight arriving early on the 10th. We will have transfers waiting for you. Fly Out: The majority will be leaving late in the evening on the 23rd May. If you would like to extend your stay, please let us know and we will help arrange this for you at the best possible rate.
Internal flight from CAI to SSH	Air Cairo: Direct Flight 19th May 12:30 CAI -> 14:00 SSH, 1x hold luggage is also included.
Are transfers included?	Yes, all transfers from and to airports, to excursions, boat trips, quadbike rentals are included in your package.
Do I need a Visa?	Most likely no, you do need a visa. UK passport holders: as we are stay less than 15 days, you do not need a visa, You will get a free entry permission stamp on arrival. If you plan to travel outside the resorts or stay more than 15 days, you must get a visa. You can get a visa at Sharm el Sheikh airport or online.
	Passport holders from other countries: refer to the travel advice provided by your own government or local consulate. Please be aware that passport and visa requirements can change before departure, so it's important to stay updated with the latest information.

FAQS Egypt

Local tipping guidelines?	Please note that tips are not included. Tipping is part of the culture in Egypt. Tips (or baksheesh) can range from 5 EGP (<£0.15) to 150 EGP (£4), depending on who you are paying and where. Restaurants and cafes are easier to figure out, with 10-15% of the bill being customary, and loose change is the norm for food purchases from street vendors. We recommend budgeting: • 50-100EGP for excursion drivers in Cairo and Luxor, and Desert Safari • 200-300EGP for our excursion guides in Cairo and Luxor, and our boat captain.
Will this itinerary change?	The itinerary, activities and hotels are subject to change, however this is very unlikey. These changes can happen due to availability, poor weather, seasonal changes, or other circumstances beyond our control – but we'll always do our best to ensure it has little impact on your experience.
Let's Talk Water	Drinking tap water in Egypt is not recommended due to the high chlorine levels. The water is considered safe in Cairo but bottled, and filtered water is readily available and recommended. Let's just say, bottled.
What should I pack?	 Valid passport with at least six months validity Cash, credit/debit card or foreign exchange for expenses Scarf for women to cover head and shoulders when visiting mosques, Bandana or scarf to wrap around your face for ATVs in the desert. Activewear, swimwear, jumper/sweater (evening) Sunhat/sunglasses, high SPF Power bank and universal adapters, a small backpack or tote bag to carry daily essentials. Any personal medications
